

Higgins is the 2019 recipient of AdventHealth's "Keep Me Safe" award for her division.



Deborah Jones, RN, MSN, CCDS, is the CDI director at Brigham and Women's Hospital, a large academic medical center affiliated with Harvard Medical School in Boston. Reporting to the quality and safety department, the CDI team collaborates with quality professionals, clinical teams, health information management, and coding to ensure the accuracy and integrity of the medical record. Since taking on the director role in October 2017, Jones expanded the program to include commercial payer reviews and risk adjustment queries and doubled the number of CDI staff at the facility.



Debbie Martin, RN, MSN, CCDS, is the CDI manager for Vidant Health, a multihospital health system in eastern North Carolina. She has more than 30 years of experience in critical care, occupational health, clinical information analytics, and CDI. In her current role, Martin oversees 16 CDI specialists and serves on the system's Patient Safety Indicator review committee.
